3. Action on April 2010 meeting minutes: Motion by Wilkes 2nd by Boughton
4. Correspondence and Resolutions: Letters read by Secy from SCEMA requesting update for Emergency Operations Plan.


We have been contacted by Butch Coleman of the Endless Mountain Stone Company. It is our understanding firm is applying for a small mine permit for use on his property in Lanesboro, situated along Depot St and Mountain Road, with the property located north of the Starrucca Creek.

Please consider this a conditional letter of support of this permit, as it will generate some new job opportunities in a distressed area of Susquehanna County. As stated, Lanesboro's support is conditional, based on the successful development of a Roadway Use Agreement (RUA) for Depot St and Mountain Road. Both of these roads are local municipally owned roadways that cannot withstand the heavy loads associated with large trucks. The RUA will address this local concern, and must be implemented prior to work occurring on the subject property.
