

September 4, 2012 Lanesboro Council Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00PM by President Todd Glover

1. Action on August 7, 2012 meeting minutes: Motion to accept as presented by J. Fissel 2nd by D. Boughton.
2. Correspondence and Resolutions: None received.
3. Visitors requesting time on the agenda: John Baker filed a formal complaint against Officer Michael DeVries regarding an incident in Thompson on August 2, 2012. He had already discussed said complaint with Chief Smith. Mayor Maby and Council President Glover will follow up on complaint with a meeting with Chief Smith and Officer DeVries.
4. Public Comment: Paul Skasko again stated a request to have a ditch repaired on his property. A neighbor gave permission for State to dig a ditch but the ditch is in center of Skasko property. Skasko requested the ditch be dug at the back side of his property. Glover to follow up.
5. Police Report: Given by Chief Smith and read by President Glover. Copies to all.
6. COG – Report previously sent to all council members via e-mail. Atty. Dewitt requested information on 2012 International Property Codes adoption – Secy to furnish info so ordinance can be adopted at October meeting.
7. Streets: Work at base of Jefferson St completed. Councilman Glidden cut back brush on Grand St. Glover working on agility program for future work to be done. Excess street millings at Luciana Park. Discussion of where to use – Side Ave, Grand St. Decision on hold. Rocks are being moved on Depot Street – a closed road. Road not safe.
8. Parks & Recreation: Councilman Fissel picked up new picnic tables for Luciana Park. They now need to be painted. Wilkes advised she would contact the Boy Scouts for the painting. Fissel spread street milling where needed in the park. He also reported that the grills should be replaced in Spring of 2013.

9. Sewer/Refuse: Garbage truck is at Cleveland's for repairs again. No decision has been made on the replacement of the recycling bin. Preliminary costs are between \$4,000. and \$6,000. King pins in the truck lacking grease. Todd and Chris again in discussion with Tri Boro Municipal over the purchase of Sewer. Will advise when the meeting will be.

10. Community Center: Rentals have slow. After discussion over tile in bathroom's not adhering – Fissel will get refund on tile and purchase ceramic tile and install. Discussion on a rental date change – a no charge for a benefit - if the date changes there will be a charge.

11. Old Business: No word on FEMA as yet. No bills received from Harmony Township for work done. Swift Reach forms are coming in and the program will be set in motion soon. Bids to be accepted 9/5/12 on the demolition of Boro Hall.

12. New Business: Plow truck needs repair before bad weather.
